I am still so upset that we did not see each other when I was in South Africa. I was looking forward to it so much.

As I write to you today, in a week's time it will be the tenth anniversary of Bob's death, I know how much I miss him; your pain and sense of loss will, I know, be immeasurably greater. I wish I knew what comfort to offer you, I can but tell you that Anne and I treasure his memory. We often speak about him and remember all the beauty that was in him. I hope that the book I am writing will be enough of a tribute to him.

As you might have heard, the PAC have invited me to New York to speak at the United Nations on February 26. They tell me Dini will be there, so I am looking forward to seeing him again. But I do not know if Miliswa will be there, if she isn't I shall phone her, I will send you a copy of my speach as soon as I have finished writing it.

We send you our love, and our heartfalt wishes that you are all right.
