At 4 p.m. we had a ~~tea~~-party for the Europeans of the Mission in the Dining-Hall. After tea we had carols in Chapel & then began the Queen's Speech in the Parlor. Unfortunately the batteries gave out & we only heard half the speech.

The children had a party at S.J.B where they all enjoyed themselves immensely.

After the visitors had gone we cleared up & had Vespers & had a rather supper nearby bed.

26<sup>th</sup> S. Stephen's Day. Superior took Dorothy F. MacLean & cated the 12 o'clock train to Cape Town. Superior, S.D & the two visitors later he went on to see Freddy & then had a picnic on the road back in full view of the Drakensberg. The visitors had supper in bed.

28<sup>th</sup> The Holy Innocents. H. Caine then Sister M. Baumern came to tea.

- 31<sup>st</sup>: New Year's Eve - S. Irene, & S. Phyllis went for a walk with the B's & the river. The Maids were going a party in the Dining-Hall - our three, two from Key Cottage & three from the Hospital. We had Saints & mottoes after Compline.

January 1<sup>st</sup>: D. Fehsen returned from C'Town and there was an expedition to Roeliear to meet her. SAC took S. Phyllis.

Wally & Alettes came to tea as a farewell to Alettes. Peggy Lutherford & the Lenetons arrived from St. Barnabas in the middle of the.

January 1<sup>st</sup>: We had the B's party at 3.30 p.m. We began with Carols in Chapel & then had tea & games in the John Dennis - Hall. A very happy party. The Taylors left for their holiday & then to Alice.

2<sup>nd</sup>: The Wriggins left for their holiday. SAC took S.P. & S.V.F. to Nsijja & Noraywana - SS & S. Irene took tea out to Red Hall.

3<sup>rd</sup>: S.M.M. went to Blantyre with M.M. Zeeman. S. Irene & S. Phyllis went to the Mountain & got up to the Shoulder.

\* 4<sup>th</sup>: See above.

5<sup>th</sup>: Our three visiting Sisters were in retreat. SAC went to Blantyre.

6<sup>th</sup>: Father Young arrived from Cape Town. Epiphany

8<sup>th</sup> S.S. took S. Dene, S. V. Faith & S. Phyllis to the Dene Falls - we took morning tea & were back to Limerick. At one point we struck in the mud but got out after advice from the driver of a lorry that came along. When we got back S. Dene found she had left her bag by the roadside & after phoning up the Seneca Store, it came back in the afternoon by Mr. van der Walt who was at the Essequibon Store for a clinic - wonderful police work! -

9<sup>th</sup> S. Dene & S. V. Faith departed. S.A.C. took them to Tolo for the luxury bus to Manlyburn. Mrs. Macaulay arrived at 5.30 from Manlyburn & was met by S.A.C. & Dorothy.

10<sup>th</sup> Our Long Retreat began at 7.30 p.m. led by Fr. Young.

11<sup>th</sup> In retreat. D. Fehsen kept house for us. S.C. was out of retreat.

12<sup>th</sup> S. Phyllis was taken to the bus by Dorothy - she left by the E. 35 bus to Kalkstad. Wally & Dorothy left for Holy Cross by the luxury bus.

13<sup>th</sup> In retreat.

14<sup>th</sup> In retreat.

15<sup>th</sup> We came out of retreat.

16<sup>th</sup> M.M. Boatflower arrived at 5.30 p.m. & Margaret Wattie arrived back by car to Tolo. Her letter only arrived that afternoon & she had to be fetched from Tolo Hotel by M.M. Zeeman after Joyce B. had arrived.

17<sup>th</sup> S.M.M. went to Tolo to get her car license. Mr. Zeeman took her & she had no test. On the way back he gave her a final lesson.

18<sup>th</sup> Epiphany II.

- 19<sup>th</sup>: The girls were due back but only about 20 arrived.

20<sup>th</sup>: 1<sup>st</sup> day of term. More girls arrived in the course of today. Hospital Executive meetings at 7.30 p.m.

21<sup>st</sup>:

22<sup>nd</sup>: S.M.N. went to S. Barnabas & stay two nights.  
Mrs Zeeman went with her & brought the car back.

23<sup>rd</sup>: Sister Ida arrived at 5.30 p.m.

24<sup>th</sup>: S.S. took Joyce Boltflower, Mrs Macaulay & M. Watkins to S. Barnabas & bring S.M.N. back. We picnicked on the way back by the lagoon.

25<sup>th</sup>: Epiphany III.  
S.C. was in retreat. SD & S.D.P. went to the out-station Elangeniwezi & arrived back to dinner. Joyce B. & Mrs Preston took a picnic lunch up the river.

26<sup>th</sup>: Beatrice Nguenina returned to school.

27<sup>th</sup>: S.S. took Joyce B. & Mrs Macaulay & have lunch ~~step~~ at Mokathana with Daniel & Dorothy Maguire & S. Florence. These went. Mother E. & S. Isabella came back.

28<sup>th</sup>: There was a meeting about Sunday School with Fr Gardner, Mother E. & S.S. at S. Joseph's Office at 6 p.m. Four girls went home to fetch Book money.

29<sup>th</sup>: Joyce B. & Mrs Macaulay went for a walk with S. Ida up the river. Three girls arrived back.

30<sup>th</sup>: S. Ida was in retreat. Joyce B. & Mrs Macaulay paid a visit to St. J.B. The fourth girl arrived back. Mother Euphemia went to Mokathana for a night: she was fetched by Mrs Drewe.

30<sup>th</sup>: Joyce Boltflower went off by the luxury bus to Durban. SAC & S. Ida went with her to Hob & on to Umzinto. Mrs Zeeman went too & S. Tabitha & S. Nina: S.T. should have been interpreting for a Confirmation class but S.B. agreed to take her place.

31<sup>st</sup>: S. Ida had b.i.m.b. Later she went for a walk

with Sheila Macaulay and in the afternoon with Sister Charity. The weather was a little uncertain. Muriel Drewe brought Mother back & S. Florence Theresa with her. The latter has gone into hospital. Muriel came to have a poisoned finger attended to & stayed two nights in S. Anne.

Feb. 1<sup>st</sup> Septuagesima.

Muriel was with us at tea. We had a sermon from Father Cardoso on Septuagesima.

Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup> Candlemas.

We had the Blessing & Distribution of Candles before Mass in our chapel. Father Cardoso came. We had the service from our Altar Book & sang the Antiphon A light to lighten the faintle. There would have been time for the Nunc Dimittis as a whole which would have been better. Father came in without his Chasuble on & put it on, <sup>in Chapel</sup> after the Distribution. All eight sisters were there & S. Tatini & S. Bertha & four seculars.

We had High Mass at 8.15 a.m.

Talked Morning Tea & sweets.

S. Ida & S. Macaulay went for a walk Belgrave.  
Talked Tea & sweets - Mother E. came.

Muriel Drewe went home after morning tea & took a nurse & a S. Margaret's girl to take care of her.

3<sup>rd</sup> Rather a wet day. M. Macaulay had a cold.

4<sup>th</sup> Weather improved.

5<sup>th</sup> S.S. took S. Ida & M. Macaulay out with picnic lunch, starting about 10.45 a.m. We intended to go up to Ngcale Cherich but got a puncture in the left front tyre about a mile and a half out. S.S. walked back & got help & Sandy came out in the jeep & changed the wheel. We then went on to Hobo & leave the wheel at Shepherds.

February 1953

and went on \$71 boatwards with lunch on the way. We fetched a red chair wanted by S. R. Many & brought back S. Isabella's luggage and had tea with Rosalie & Dorothy, leaving about 4 o'clock. We found the inner tube was riddled & we must have a new one so came on without the spare wheel. S.S. did business at the P.O. & M<sup>r</sup> Hart's Office & M<sup>r</sup> Macaulay got us very welcome cold drinks at the 'Cafe'.

- 6<sup>th</sup>. After Vespers Superior called on M<sup>r</sup> Robey & received a present of grapes. Devotions at 5 p.m.
- 7<sup>th</sup>. The tyre came back, brought by D<sup>r</sup> Leanne when he met his lady love in Hobo <sup>Father Leanne, friend</sup> children's confession at 4 p.m.
- 8<sup>th</sup>. Sesageamia. Mass in Chapel.  
S. C. was in retreat.  
It was wet so nobody went to Clugencarrow.  
M<sup>r</sup> Robey came & tea.
- 9<sup>th</sup>. It was a wet day. S. Ida & S. H.V. were in retreat.
- 10<sup>th</sup>. Superior was in retreat. S. A.C. went to Cluny.
- 11<sup>th</sup>. It was fine & S. Ida & M<sup>r</sup> Macaulay went for a walk Belo-Wards in the morning.  
<sup>Father Shrine came for Sister's Confession.</sup>  
<sup>Father Provincial arrived.</sup>
- 12<sup>th</sup>. M<sup>r</sup> Macaulay helped D<sup>r</sup> Mrs. Drove at School with a leprosy examination. Father Provincial came to see Superior.  
SAC took M<sup>r</sup> M<sup>r</sup> & S. Ida to Ngcale Church - had a picnic lunch & returned early.  
At 4 p.m. S.S. & SAC went to a very interesting Brothers' Union meeting.
- 13<sup>th</sup>. There was a Confirmation at Ngadeu.  
S.S. & S. Ida took a picnic supper to the river.  
S.S. talked to the children about Lent in the School Hall at 9.45 p.m. <sup>M.E. S.M.M. & S.D. were in retreat</sup> Father & M<sup>r</sup> Tanner called - they knew <sup>to go to bed in very old days</sup>.
- 14<sup>th</sup>. Confirmation Day at S. Cuthbert's. There

were 46 women & girls & about an equal number of boys & men. 55. S.A.C., S. Berths & 5 groupers put on veils in the School Room at 2 p.m. The candidates went onto Church for Evensong at ~~at~~ 2.30. The Confirmation was at 3.0. There was the usual rush to find late-comers white dresses. A nurse & a hospital maid were confirmed & they had a retreat at C.S.V.B.

In the evening the girls had a short Service <sup>Practise</sup> with S. Berths. The S. Joseph's Boys came.

15<sup>th</sup> <sup>An Graham arrived, on a visit.</sup> Quingprafesma. The Bishop said our Mass at 7.0. It was the First Communion. 85 & S.A.C. went up with the groupers for veils at 8.15 a.m. We had Prime & Terce before Mass at 6.30 a.m. The Hostel girls - choir in front - sat in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel.

S.D & S.M. went to Elugenevire but found the church shut & nobody there. They were all at the First Communion. S.M. visited a leather kraal.

Mrs. Braby came for tea. <sup>The</sup> ~~the~~ <sup>Wright</sup> came to play for the Bishop's practise. <sup>Elder went into hospital with appendicitis.</sup> The Bishop preached at Evensong.

16<sup>th</sup> Mass in Chapel at 6.30 a.m. S.A.C. took S. Ida & Iola for her Mass. Auntie went to Botswana for her daughter's Confirmation. She had a lift in the car. Nellie went to Umtata to catch her bus home as her relatives want her. S.H.U. went to Umtata also. Nonabetswe & Muriel went to hospital for treatment for boils.

Father Provincial went away.

17<sup>th</sup> Shrove Tuesday.

Mrs Leith-Ross came to the Mission with her brother & had lunch at the Wrights.
