Twenty European Youth were arrested and charged for "Illegally" entering Orlando. They will be appearing in the Johannesburg Magistrate's Court on Thursday March the 25th at 9a.m.

The Transvaal Festival Committee has strongly protest against this unwarranted interference by the police. It regards it as an attempt to intimidate the people and to disrupt the arrangements that are being made for the Festival..

The Festival Committee calls upon your organization to lodge your protest against this police action and request you to call upon your members to be present at the court on Thursday morning to show your solidarity and support for the Festival.
