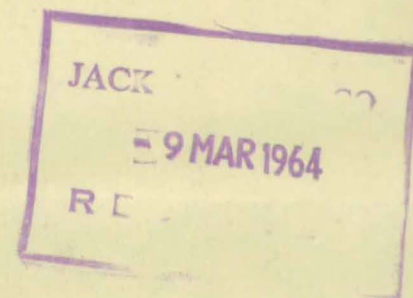

- (b) Advocated or encouraged the promotion of the purposes of the said organization.


The exact time or period, as requested, is to the prosecutor unknown. See the period mentioned in Count 2. >

The place was at or in the near vicinity of the Rotunda Hotel, Camps Bay.

Ad 2:

The accused are charged jointly by virtue of the fact that it is alleged that the accused committed the offences at the same place and/or at the same or approximately the same time. See particulars Ad 1.
