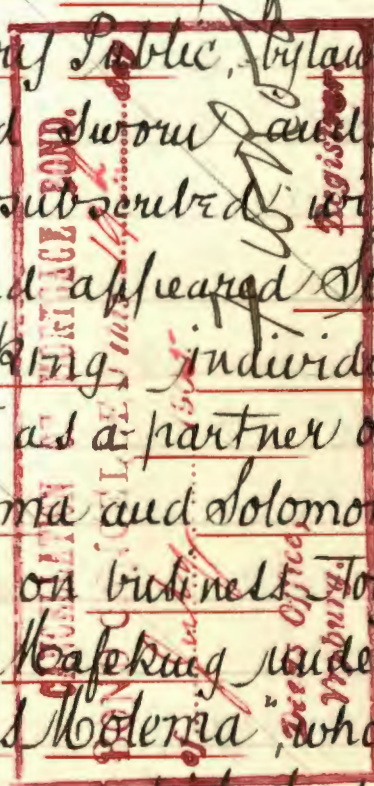

of Wafeking, in the Colony of the Cape of Good Hope Notary Public, by lawful authority duly admitted and sworn and in the presence of the subscribed witnesses, personally came and appeared Silas Tau Moletia, of Wafeking, individually and in his capacity as a partner of the firm of Silas Tau Moletia and Solomon Tshekisho Plaatje carrying on business together in co-partnership at Wafeking under the style or firm of "Silas Moletia", who acknowledged himself and his said firm to be truly and lawfully indebted unto and on behalf of Charles Wenham of Wafeking in the sum of Six Hundred and Fifty Pounds Sterling (£650) of lawful money arising from and being money duly lent and advanced to him and to his said firm
