In sel 209 tref ek aangehoudene Neil Aggett aan waar hy aan 'n stuk materiaal hang - dit het die voorkoms van 'n sero. Die een ent op sy nek vasgemaak en die ander ent was aan die tralies aan die binnekant van die sel vasgemaak. Hy het ongeveer 6 duim van die grond gehang.

Die persoon was klaarblyklik dood, en nadat foto's geneem was na brigadier Swanepoel, wie 'n rukkie na my by die selle aangekom het opdrag gegee dat die stuk materiaal waaraan die persoon gehang het losgesny word.

Ek het die stuk materiaal ongeveer halfpad tussen die twee knope afgesny sodat die een stuk om die persoon se nek agtergebly het en die ander stuk aan die traliewerk. Brig. Swanepoel en twee uniformlede het my gehelp.

Hierne was die lyk na die Laboratoriums verwyder.

Ek het vir Neil Aggett op geen stadium ondervra nie. Ek dra ook geen kennis van enige aanranding op Neil Aggett nie.
