The allies were suffering almost defeat from the Nazi forces. At that time I was one of the few men who believed that the allied forces were sure to win the war. Most of my friends did not think so. Your first duties were more or less connected with the war effort.

It was during that period when I uttered those words which I quoted on Saturday to your audience. That you were the pioneer and the ambassador in the vicissitude of the white world.

It is indeed gratifying to me to live to know that those words stuck in your memory up to this day.

Your speech on Saturday was excellent. Surveying your life history from part of your school days to your Swaziland experience then to the job you are doing now as an entertainer who has been accepted by the international society of entertainers whose Head Quarters are in U.S.A.

I congratulate you for your signal attainment. You broke the virgin ground in the entertainment world. You deserve every praise in the world.
