Affair City Council). Charges that illicit liquor brought into beerhall, equally refuted as

barbarous. On the other ^{hand} ^{of} ^{disparaging} ^{exhibition} ^{of} ^{this} described as premeditated, gangsterism and Hobgoblinism by the "Natives". A number of

firms ^{have} ^{signed} ^{petition} jumped in to provide a solution ^{for} ^{another} ^{removal}. ^{petitioning} to City Council - "Remove the Beerhall".
