My Dear Mr. Champion/

Will you please send me the 100. of the tickets you have on hand. This is very urgent.

This week-end I am meeting at Colenso a number of Farm Labourers interested in my scheme. I certainly will require membership cards when I go there.

I saw in the "Ilanga" the itinerary of the M.R.C.'s for the Province. I am urging the branches to make all the arrangements necessary for your meetings and seize the opportunity by registering members.

I am suggesting that you will be having with you membership cards. Can you please approach Dr. Xuma to make all that possible. You might mention to him, that I have not received from the Head Office an "Invoice" for the cards left with you and that on receipt of same a settlement will be effected.
