17 servers from Pretoria + Johannesburg came over for a quiet day. Tense as usual was at 9.15. Sext + None 1, Vespers 5.30. The retreatants had the use of Chapel, Recreation Room, Cottage stoop + garden all day. Most of them left after Solemn Evensong at 4.30 p.m., but 3 stayed + went back to Johannesburg with Fr. Alekin by the 7 p.m. train.

Fri: June 1st. 7.15 Mass. Girls danced in the evening as they had not been able to do so the previous day.

Sat: 2nd. 7.15. Mass. Miss Rightley + Miss Betty Reves came to spend the day.

Tues: 5th. Mass. 7-15. Everything as usual.

Wed: 6th. No Mass. Evensong + Instruction 6-4.5.

Thurs 7th Mass 7-15: Mother went
Octave Day into Proctoria to M^{rs} Jenkins
for the Monthly Meeting
of the Women's Working
Party for Irene. Promises
were made of blankets for
the Home. In the after-
noon the plumbers called
about starting the work
in connection with the
sanitation of the Homes

tea. Eve Middleton, +
Barbara Threadgold came
from E. Antler for the
Night. Solemn Evensong

was not - until 6-40 p.m.
owing to Evensong at the
Church being at 5-30 p.m.
All the offerings to-day were
given to the enlargement
of the Lepers Chapel in
Protona. £2. 5. 6. was
made.

Fri: Cont^d. St. Martha poorly, & had to go to bed. Kitchen girls did the cooking very nicely. Sr. Ry & S. P. E. to town in van.

Sat: 23rd. Mass 7.15. Host was buried in the cemetery at 3 p.m. Sr. Editha & S. P. Baptista arrived by the 7 p.m. train. S. P. B. went straight to the Pole - Evans'.

Sun: 24th. Nativity of St. J. B. Sung Nativity Mass at 7.30. In the afternoon Miss Myers & 5 friends (the Baptists) came to see the Homes.

Miss Beetham also came over, & brought some clothes for the girls. Solemn Evensong & Sermon at 6.40 p.m. S.A. still in bed.

Mon: 25th. No Mass. S. Ad: better, & up for a little while. St. Martha also better, & up, too, for a short time. Mother returned

Tues: 26th at 7 p.m. from Jane Fruse & was met by Sister Marjorie & Sister Mary Cornelia with the car. Mrs. Wayne Stanley & friends called.

Tues: 26th Mass 7-15. The work was begun for the lavatories etc. Sister Mary Baptista came to Mass & breakfast. Miss Van den Berg & two students from Proctoria came to see the Homes. Sister Adelaide better but went to bed after Vespers.

Wed: 28th No Mass. M^{rs} Brown, H^{rs}

Baxter, Miss Worganhart called to see the Homes. M^{rs} Constable called to see S^r M.C. about frogs. Aletta & Nellie were conditionally baptized.

Fri: 29th Sung Mass. 7-15. At 2-30. Sister St. Peter's Day. Margie drove Mother & three of the girls being confirmed to the Bishop's for their Confirmation. Nellie, Aletta, & Mabel. The Confirmation was in the Bishop's Private Chapel. The Chaplain & M^{rs} P. Jones were there. Miss Boltha was also confirmed & returned to Irene in the car. Dorothy Maud & Peg Leake came for a night. Sister Felicitas, Sister Irene, Sister Dorothy Helen & Sister Joyce came for the week end in the Van.
