1<sup>st</sup> July Mass 7. Mission Strike had in Tues: 9burg & vicinity - S. Supr's eye still bad S. A. came out - S. Grace to sleep at Dursey

2<sup>nd</sup> Wed Mass at 7. S. Supr. into Pretoria Y.S.M.V. to meet the Bishop at D.S.G. re the Colored School - she returned by the 6 o'clk train -

3<sup>rd</sup> Thurs: No Mass. Parktown people put off coming to see H. of M. - F. Deacon up to hear one Confession -

4<sup>th</sup> Friday Mass 7 - Strike very bad - Associates' hours commenced -

5<sup>th</sup> Sat No Mass - Strike v. bad. Park Station burnt - line destroyed - General Anarchy - Sister's Retreat was to have commenced but no Sister came from Pretoria or 7burg & the Conductor did not arrive he was stopped at Krugersdorp. "Nell" had a heifer at 6 o'clk!

6<sup>th</sup> Sunday No Mass - "Commendments" at 8 -

July 1913

Strike over but riots in 7' hour -  
military out - martial law -  
a good many killed & wounded  
no communication into either 7' hour  
or Trebaria - no trains running  
no telegraph or telephones -  
had shunder stores - At 11.40  
p.m. we were woken up by the  
2 Sisters from B'fonkeni arriving  
they had gone Mrs's father had
