of our African Working Comrades at Manganese Mines having seen the very bad conditions of the African Workers all that area of Griqualand West, we thought of starting from Postmassburg Mangenese Mines, and are doing well although our request Dr.is that, whenever you held meetings in the area please express as much as you can to the Workers that they should join the Trade Union movement.

The conditions of the employment is horrible, we have already made it our duty to come and help those African Working Comrades in that area.

Undertaking this task of organizing Griqualand West, means financial Assistance; be asked by our Union from prominent leaders like Dr.Molema and others, Mr.Molteno M.P. who has also been written similar letters.

Mr.Molteno has already been informed of a defunct Advisory Board Postmassburg by the Mangenese Workers' Union which matter he is taking up with the Native Affairs.

Dr. The Cement, Cement Products and Lime Workers' Union have been advised by their Book Keeper that the revenue of their Union being drained by travelling expences in particular that the Postmassburg Mangenese Mines. We then thought of making an appeal to you and Mr. Molteno to pleasing an advice as having men to assist us, but no funds.

Our Union is about to lunch the second Union which will be that of the Municipalities of Griqualand Towns, starting from Postmassburg, Barkley, Kimberley, Douglas, Vryburg, Mafeking, etc.

We are convinced that outside African workers should be helped by forming such Unions and officials of reason that they cannot excessive subscriptions and again there are certain facilities that we do not have as the European sections, owing to such laws such as C.I.Act etc.

Dr. the brief explanation made to you whether will it be of some help, to what is intended for, we cannot say, it is particularly made for the little outline on Trade Unionism.

As one of our prominent leader in the National Congress, your name has time and again mentioned when we were at Mangenese Mines by the Working men of Mafeking, our own particular mission was that of organizing workers into Trade Unionism. You may be pleased to learn that the Cement, Cement and Lime Workers' Union have initiated the formation of the African Mangenes Workers' Union which has elected a Sub-Committee of nine(9) members to start the Ball rolling having a membership of a little over one hundred, as from the end of May this year to date, organizers of the Cement, Cement Industries together with myself having seen the very bad conditions of the African Workers of that area, we would estimate a great favour to meet by such men as yourself, and others by financial assistance so as to combant the whole area into Trade Unionism.

Sir, should we get your earliest reply we would esteem it a great favour.
