- 4. It is expressly stipulated that the premises referred to shall be used as a Printing Office and Stationery Shop and that no occupants shall be allowed to sleep on the premises.
- 5. The Lessee shall not sublet the premises except with the Lessor's written permission
- 6. The Lessees shall have the right to renew this Lease at the present rental, for a further peiod of TWELVE MONTHS for which SIX MONTHS Notice shall be
