S<sup>r</sup> Annette still poorly. Evensong, 6.30. Miss Galt arrived with Miss Linskey a girl from Johannesburg. who desired to be

taken in. Capt: kept called to cook house & send letters to Hospital.

7<sup>th</sup> 3. of Holy Name.

J.P. Cole said Mass heard confessions. S.H. took S.A. up to School to be nursed. Then took Comfort up to Hospital through back Hannels. Mr. Jack keeps Leishey's young man called to see if he was here but was sent away with no definite answer. Ellen went away to stay with her sister till Tuesday. Ethel also went to her mother's.

27<sup>th</sup> Thurs: Mr. Wilkin said Mass. Miss Hoff called about some needlework. Annie Mueller called again. Charlotte Mueller (Parrish Lamb) called to see S.S. in. Vivian Robson arrived sent by Tuttle Superior Howard. Mr. King called to see S.H.

Fri. 28<sup>th</sup> No Mass in the House. S.D.C. in Retreat.

Sat. 29<sup>th</sup> Mr. Tesson said Mass. F. Cole called about 9 a.m. to say he would come in the afternoon. Mr. Macblachlan called. Mr. Gibbons & Miss Gole-Broune called. Vespers at 1.30. F. Cole came to hear Confessions. Sister

Sun. 30<sup>th</sup> XI Sunday after Trinity

S.H.C went to 11<sup>o</sup> Mass with Maria. The others  
went with Sister 7<sup>o</sup>. After breakfast - noticed  
Gordon was not well. sent for D<sup>r</sup> Davies  
He could not come. asked D<sup>r</sup> Sanders. He  
called in at 11.30 again at 5 p.m.  
nothing much could be done. D<sup>r</sup> Davies  
came about 5.30. He thought it was brain  
disease. Child very feeble. F<sup>r</sup> Cole came  
for Maria. also Evenson & Address -  
Clara Katharine came also let air to  
let. Katharine fetched Gertrude away.  
Miss Cole H.H. sat up with Gordon. till  
he died 3.45 a.m. 5 p.m. Florence stayed  
till 11 p.m. They were both fetched again  
just after he died. S.H. Miss C. went  
off to bed 4.45. Stayed there to break-  
fast.

Mon. 31<sup>st</sup> no one went to Church. Miss C. went  
to tell D<sup>r</sup> Sanders about Baby also D<sup>r</sup> Davies  
also to tell F<sup>r</sup> Cole & undertaker.  
Undertaker called. arranged for funeral  
3 p.m. D<sup>r</sup> Davies called with death  
certificate. F<sup>r</sup> Cole came to take  
services in Chapel just - at 2.45.  
Undertaker brought Coffin. S.H. Florence  
went in the coach to the funeral.  
S.H. came Home then went off to  
D.S.G. to pick up S<sup>r</sup> Lillian to go to
