He called in at 11.30 again at 5 p.m. nothing much could be done. Dr. Davies came about 5.30. He thought it was brain disease. Child very feeble. F. Cole came for Maria. also Evensong & Address. Clara Katherine came also Maria & Leo. Katherine sent Gertrude away. Miss C. set up with Gordon. till he died 3.45 a.m. 8.5 m. Florence stayed till 11 p.m. They were both feebled again just after he died. S.H. Miss C. went off to bed 4.45. Stayed there to breakfast.

no one went to Church. Miss C. went to tell Dr. Sanders about Baby also Dr. Davies also to tell F. Cole & undertaker. Undertaker called.
