

PRESS STATEMENTS

A number of prominent South Africans of all races and walks of life have issued the following statement:-

HANDS OFF EGYPT.

"We express our grave anxiety over the intervention of Israeli forces on Egyptian territory, which has been used as a pretext by the British and French Governments for one-sided military action in Egypt.

"These actions cannot be justified by any alleged provocations. In fact they are acts of aggression, in violation of the United Nations Charter, which endangers peace in Africa, Asia and throughout the world.

"On behalf of all peace-loving South African people we demand an end to force and the withdrawal of all foreign troops from Egyptian territory. We express our sympathy with the Egyptian people and our support for their just claim to sovereignty in their own country.
