

Sobukwe can stay with Cape doctor

CAPE TOWN. — Mr Robert Sobukwe, the banned former leader of the Pan African Congress, can stay in Cape Town for two weeks to recuperate after his operation in Groote Schuur Hospital.

On Friday, shortly after being discharged from hospital, Mr Sobukwe was ordered to leave the Newlands house of Bishop P M Matolengwe where it was hoped he would be able to recuperate.

"He had hardly been here 20 minutes when the Security Police arrived," a spokesman at the bishop's house, who did not want to be named, said.

The police gave Mr Sobukwe an order from the Minister of Justice to leave the bishop's house within two hours.

Now he has been granted permission to stay with Cape Town doctor for two weeks.

Mr Sobukwe's wife, Veronica, would not say who the doctor was, only that he was a friend from Groote Schuur Hospital.

"My husband is very tired after moving," she added. — Sapa.
