The files were left with Monde Jolobe by the P.A.C. executive as it was agreed that he should be the only one who will not launch in the 1960 campaign.On March 21st 1960, Monted Not mysteriously joined Jolobe saying that he was instructed by Sobukwe not to go to gaol.

As time went on, Jolobe and Nkosi were in charge of the organisation **xxx** even when it was banned.Stanley Nkosi who was made acting president during the State of Emergency was in charge of the organisation. When A.B.Ngcobo was released from gaol, he took charge of the organisation thus eleminating Nkosi i.e. Stanley. This upset Molly Nkosi and soon the rest of the P.A.C. top brass at that time was arrested. Molly Nkosi left the Republic and the African **XXXXX** States then were told not to accept him by the Basutoland Secretariat.A curious thing happened at this time.

Ntsu Mokhetle received a letter for Monde Jolobe from a police chief in Mafeking.Mokhetle had opened the letter thinking that it was some urgent matter from Ghana that had to be attended to.The letter was instructing Monde to go to Ghana and that a passport and some expense money were waiting for him in Mafeking.Mokhetle conveyed this message to the Basutoland Secretariat.Monde was relieved of some official work. taken Duma Mgaju was baiked out of gaol with money left by K.

Barden of Ghana.Duma confiscated the files from Monde and they were buried in the yard of P.K.Leballo.When Leballo came out of gaol and was banished to some remote area in Zululand, police began to put pressure on his wife. Some P.A.C. enthusiasts dug up the files and they were taken to the West Rand branches.

Jerry Louw who belonged to the Orlando West group was instructed to go and fetch the files. This was done when the P.A.C. was preparing to launch another campaign from Basutoland. Jerry got the files and they were taken to P.K.Leballo. These were the files from which P.K.Leballo got addresses to instruct people about his future pakes plans, the plans that

he released to the press in his famous conference where he got Sobukwe to be taken to gaol.
