Service slams Swazi govt

Swazi government was heavily criticised by its and youths in Soweto yesterday, for giving a state funeral to ANC cadres who were killed during clashes with Swaziland's security forces.

A memorial service for the two held at the chapel near Maponya, speaker after speaker criticised foreign power of complicity in what was atrocities perpetrated against fellow South Africans in exile.

Gretta Ncapayi of the Federation of South African Women (Fedsaw) said: "Our children are like criminals and animals in Swaziland. People are being indoctrinated through radio and television to spy on strange people they see in their neighbours' houses."

Speaker praised those western countries which had snubbed Prime Minister P W Botha during his European tour.

Speaker said Mr Botha's tour did not make sense because he was trying to convince the international community that all was well in South Africa, when the facts had a different story to tell.

Speaker added that if what Mr Botha says abroad is true, he will then take that as an endorsement of repressive measures he has been taking against opponents of apartheid.
