- 1. It is very hard, especially at the present time, for Natives to get employment in the different trades.
- 2. I could not say which class of tradesmen finds it most difficult to get employment. I should say that all of them find it very hard.
- 3. An employment bureaux would certainly be welcomed and would be made use of by the Natives.
- 4. There are many Natives who would be able to build houses for other Natives. I may mention that about two years ago the Native Affairs Department of Pietermaritzburg, Natal, inserted a small advertisement one single time in our Weekly Native Paper "Um-Afrika", Them Seematanym who work inviting Natives to apply for a job of building a "dipping tank". Afterwards the Secetary wrote to me that the got over 30 applications after one single insertion. Therefore I am sure that a good Native number of Native building would report themselves if an advertisement were put in our Newspaper and also in other Native papers.
