

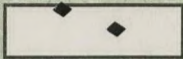

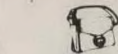

2. For travel wholly between U.S. points, Federal rules require any limit on an airline's baggage liability to be at least U.S. \$1,250 per passenger.
