A note to let you know that Veronica Sobukwe is leaving Johannesburg by train at 10.30 on Saturday, August 17, and is due to arrive in Cape Town at 2 pm on Sunday, August 18.

It would be wonderful if you could meet ~~xxx~~ her on her arrival. I am not sure what her plans are for that day, but I assume that she will have to stay in Cape Town overnight before seeing the magistrate in the morning to obtain a permit for the Island. She will be with Bob for two weeks.

If you are able to see her, and the opportunity arises on the Monday, could she perhaps be taken to a delicatessen so that she can buy some special food for Bob? She will probably want to buy an assortment of kosher food such as one or two polonies, a kitke bread and a jar of chicken fat, and perhaps some sausages.

She will, by the way, be provided with cash for the trip so there is no need for aid on this level for a change! I have today sent money to the authorities to cover her meals on the Island.
