Report to the S.W. Region

In submitting this Report, we wish to mention that this report was prepared and submitted to the Branch Executive Committee for corrections and approval.

I. Since January this year to August 9-1955, the following meetings have been held in the Branch:-

2. About February this year one member of the Branch was involved in a court case jointly with Moroka Member charged for collecting money from a public A.N.C. meeting. They were found guilty, and an appeal was noted. It was alleged that they did not have a written permit to collect money from the authorities. Defence money is still to be paid.

3. Removal. Number of public meetings were held to protest against the removal of western arrests. House to House campaigns were conducted and Volunteers ready in terms of disobeys from the provincial committee; and all awaiting for further provincial directives to be implemented. When the removal time came, Volunteers were directed to remain at by the organisers. They were later instructed to work for a day or prayer on house to house basis. After this had been done, Volunteers were shocked to by a report in the press, denouncing their activities. It was said that the statement was made by A.N.C. leaders and it has not been refuted up to now. As a result, a state of confusion existed.

4. Bantu Education.

The Branch influenced the formation of "Save our Children Co-ordinating Committee of the S.W. Region" which after its formation a decision was taken to boycott Bantu Schools as from April 20-1955:

On the 21 April two women were arrested in the Branch in connection with the boycott. The Branch raised a bail of £100 for the two women a lawyer was engaged at the amount of £15. The two women were found ~~not~~ guilty and fined £13 and £23 ~~respectively~~ each. The Branch has paid £30 to their cases. Thus, out of £51, the Branch still owing £21.

Though this was under the sole control of the S.W. Region. None of the S.W. Branches has assisted to above in this matter.

5. C. O. P.

A Report back meeting was held in the Branch. The Branch had about 150 delegates to the C. O. P. Conference held on June 25 & 26.

An extensive work was done on house to house campaign for the election of delegates. Explain to the people of what C. O. P. is to know and understand it.
