

MEMORANDUM OF COL/DET/CONST. P.S. MUNKICK. (62).

This witness appears to report reasonably well in the sense that his notes are in grammatical form. His reports, however, are very brief and scanty and obviously he is unable to record more than a small part of what is said. See especially Meeting 218, p. 3604. (B.19). Ex. G. 390, which meeting lasted 1½ hrs. and was reported on less than 1 page of typescript. See also Ex. G. 391, where the witness has left out several words as he was obviously unable to keep up with the speakers.

See also Meeting No. 219, p. 3605 (V.19). Ex. G. 391. Meeting lasted 1½ hrs. and is recorded on 2 pages. See also p. 3614 (V.19). where witness concedes that he is only able to write down approx. 35% of what is said.

Witness tried to mislead the Court by stating that he could always remember what language was used by every speaker. This was shown to be untrue and the witness had to concede it. See p. 3611, 3612 & 3614. (V.19).
