CARNEGIE NIE-EUROPESE BIBLIOTEEK, TRANSVAAL.

VERSLAG VIR DIE JAAR GEËINDIG 31 AUGUSTUS 1945.

Gedurende die jaar het die Biblioteek 'n groot verlies gely deur die dood van Mnr. J. A. G. Starkey, C.A. (S.A.), A.C.I.S., wat Ere-Tesourier vanaf die begin van die Biblioteek was. Mnr. E. A. Borland, B.A., F.L.A., F.S.A.L.A., is in Maart 1945 gekies om die vakante betrekking te beklee.

Die jaar 1944/45 was ook op ander wyse 'n moeilike tyd vir die Biblioteek. Die Organiseerder, Mnr. C. W. Tshetlo, het aan die einde van Mei 1945 bedank en niemand is in sy plek aangestel nie. Dus was dit nie moontlik om al die gewone statistiek, wat gebruiklik deur die Organiseerder versamel word, in hierdie verslag te gee nie. Die Komitee doen stappe om nuwe reëlings vir die toekomstige reorganisasie van die Biblioteek te tref.

STUDENTE DEPARTEMENT.

Die werk van die Studentedepartement het so groot geword dat ons klein organisasie nie aan die eise kon voldoen nie. Die Bibliotekaris van die Unie Onderwysdepartement het toegestem om die werk oor te neem as deel van die Biblioteek van die Unie Onderwysdepartement. Die boeke van die Studentedepartement word aan die Unie Onderwysdepartement oorgedra.

CARNEGIE NON-EUROPEAN LIBRARY, TRANSVAAL.

REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31st AUGUST, 1945.

During the past year the Library suffered a great loss in the death of Mr. J. A. G. Starkey, C.A. (S.A.), A.C.I.S., who had been Hon. Treasurer since the Library's inception. Mr. E. A. Borland, B.A., F.L.A., F.S.A.L.A., was elected to fill the vacant post in March, 1945.

The year 1944/45 has in other ways been a difficult period for the Library. The Organiser, Mr. C. W. Tshetlo, resigned his post at the end of May, 1945, and he has not been replaced. It has not, therefore, been possible to include in this report all the statistics usually given and normally collected by the Organiser. The Committee is taking steps to make new arrangements for the re-organisation of the Library in the future.

STUDENTS' DEPARTMENT.

The work of the Students' Department was growing to such proportions that our small organisation could not cope with the demand made upon it. The Librarian of the Union Education Department agreed to take over the work as part of the department's educational work and from August, 1945, all students were referred to the Library of the Union Education Department. The book stock of the Students' Department of the Transvaal Carnegie Non-European Library is being transferred to the Union Education Department Library.

GERMISTON AND PRETORIA NON-EUROPEAN LIBRARIES.

The Germiston and Pretoria Non-European Libraries are the only libraries for which detailed statistics are kept, and their year's work may be summarised as follows:—

GERMISTON NON-EUROPEAN LIBRARY.—During the year Mr. P. E. Maringa, full-time African Librarian of this library, resigned, and Mr. J. P. Malaza was appointed in his place, commencing work in April, 1945.

PRETORIA NON-EUROPEAN LIBRARY.—The affairs of the Pretoria Non-European Library are administered by a Sub-Committee of the Transvaal Carnegie Non-European Library, three of its members being Non-European teachers. The Pretoria Municipality makes a grant of £250 per annum towards the support of the library.

There are two libraries—one at Marabastad and a branch at Atteridgeville. The Committee has arranged that the libraries open during the afternoons and evenings, the times when the Non-European people are most likely to be free.

Marabastad.—Mr. Mbeté is full-time librarian, and also supervises the Atteridgeville branch. A new building in a more central situation, is being erected for the Marabastad library.
