Dear Sir

We have been consulted by Mr Titus Mafolo and other members of the Atteridgeville / Saulsville Residents' Organisation in connection with the proposed tariff increases in Tembisa.

On 27 July 1984 Mr van Struik advised the writer that the decision to increase the tariffs had been made on 26 April 1984, that it had thereafter been advertised twice in the Star during early June 1984, and that the increases came into effect on 1 July 1984 and covered all stands in Atteridgeville.

Mr van Struik also stated that the increase was brought about by way of a bylaw made by the Council, and that the bylaw had not yet been published in the Government Gazette.

In our view the Council is not entitled to increase the tariffs. In terms of Regulation 4 of Government Notice R1993 of 16 September 1983, the draft bylaw made by the Council will come into effect only when the Minister has caused it to be published in the Government Gazette after he has approved, amended or varied it. As the Minister has not yet caused the bylaw to be published in the Gazette, it is of no force or effect.

We must now advise that unless we have your written confirmation by Wednesday 8 August 1984 that the Council will not attempt to increase the tariffs with effect from 1 July 1984, as it has publicly stated it intends doing, application will be made to the Supreme Court for an order interdicting the Council from so increasing the tariffs.
