Heard 3 sisters, nuns. 4 poor penitents.
- 26<sup>th</sup> F<sup>r</sup> Horden said Mass - girls communicated  
W. de Rougemont arrived 8.30 p.m.

2<sup>d</sup> of All S.S.  
M<sup>r</sup>. de Rougemont came out from Pretoria by the early train. I we had Sung mass 7.45. S.H. took M<sup>r</sup>. de R. to see father Prichard's cottage. Girls stopped work at 9.30 had tea (talking) - after tea S.S.M. S.R.M. S.G. took girls for a walk. Father Hill arrived. Saw Miss Staple - also Cecilia. Solemn Evensong Procession F<sup>r</sup> Hill officiated. Heard Miss Staple's Confession after Supper. Sang Vespers 2.30 p.m. Vespers of the Dead 8.45. followed by Compline. Lands. Miss Daniells arrived to stay.

2<sup>d</sup> All Souls Day Father Hill celebrated. Sung mass. Miss Staple Communicated in her room & received Holy Unction. S.H. went with F<sup>r</sup> Hill to her. Ablutions in Chapel. F<sup>r</sup> Hill left by 11.9. train. M<sup>r</sup>. Hopley called. Anna von Brijen was brought by her two sisters as usual. M<sup>r</sup>. de Rougemont came in the evening.

- 3<sup>rd</sup> W. de Rougemont said Mass. Anna very  
unhappy not wanting to stay.  
Miss Dummell developed temperature. Miss Fiddle  
arrived. sent for D:
- 4<sup>th</sup> W. Rowan came over for Mass.  
W. de Rougemont came in the evening  
D: Davies escorted out. Took Miss Dummell  
back with him.
- 5<sup>th</sup> W. de Rougemont said Mass.

Pridham arrived 9.45 p.m. He W. de  
Rougemont slept at the cottage.

Sung Mass F? Pridham celebrated.  
W. de Rougemont assisted. Much thanksgiving  
prayers taken by F? Pridham. W. de Rougemont  
returned to Pretoria 9.54.  
Evening Sermon 6.0 p.m. Superior went  
off to Calé 7.12. Train was to Calé &  
returned. Very heavy thunderstorm.  
Sent for Frank to take F? Pridham down  
to cottage. Found them all drinking.  
Frank came up took Father back to  
the cottage. Sup? S.H. Nurse followed  
him down Calé to see if he was all  
right. Nurse stayed & slept the night there.

He decided to remain at the cottage. Supr. left 1.45 train. Fr. Pricham begged to be allowed to have a room in the House. We gave him the Community room, & folded up his bed etc for the night.
- 9<sup>th</sup> Mass 6.45. King's Birthday. Bernard in wear to station to meet 8.24 train to meet her sister - his sister - she returned.
- 10<sup>th</sup> Mass 6.45. Fr. Pricham went in to Prebory 1.45 train - to sleep the night.
- 11<sup>th</sup> No Mass. S.H. went in by 8.24 train to see D<sup>r</sup> Sanders. Superior met her there. S.H. went to see D<sup>r</sup> Savage about Alice who was bad in labour. Pricham went down to the cemetery after Vespers to bury it. "Charles". heavy thunder storm came on.

13<sup>th</sup> Mass 6.45 Alice taken worse with fits  
6.2.44. Telephoned for Dr Savage. He came

Put her on a stretcher with the nurse  
Capt & S.A. + Nurse Davenport went with  
her. Took nearly 3 hours to get there.  
S.A. Nurse returned by 1.5 train.

Sung Mass 7.30. Matins 10.45. Evensong &  
Sermon 6.15.

15<sup>th</sup> Mass 6.45. S.H. & S.G. went to see  
Mr Vander Veyl to give back the key  
of the college.

16<sup>th</sup> Mass 6.45. S.H. in Retreat. Mr Taylor  
called. Nurse went in to Pretoria to  
see Capt. Bowers. also went to see Alice who  
was very ill. Matron Alice came down to the house  
<sup>to have a rest.</sup>

17<sup>th</sup> Mass 6.45. Father went in by 11.45.  
train also S.H. to see Dr Soudan. also  
went to the School Hospital to see  
Alice who was better.  
S.H. returned by 5.40 train.

18<sup>th</sup> No Mass. Dr Pricham returned 10.45.  
Adeline came out from Pretoria. in the  
afternoon & made her confession. Dr Pricham  
gave Sister's address after home.

- 18<sup>th</sup> Mass 7.0. Bishop arrived 10.45. His Chaplain met him. Confirmation at 12.0. Rult. Christina. Gertrude. Edie. Committee meeting in the afternoon. Superior came - also several people
