TOURNAMENT RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1) The Tournament shall be conducted under the rules of the I.T.F.
- 2) Events shall be best of three sets First two sets 12 Point tie breaker (i.e. no sudden death) last set lead by 2 games.
- 3) Play shall commence at 8.30am and there shall be no lunch break.
- 4) Competitors shall wear tennis clothing.
- 5) Competitors absent when called upon to play at any time shall render themselves liable to disqualification.
- 6) Each match shall be controlled by an Umpire, whose decision shall be final on point of fact. The Referee's decision shall be final on point of Law.
- 7) The S.E.T.T.A.Executive Committee reserves the right to restrict or refuse entries, and to hold a qualifying competition as may be necessary. Entries shall be ignored without notification, unless accompanied by full amount of fees due. Fees sent for entries subsequently rejected shall be refunded.
- 8) All participants shall be required to umpire or act as linesmen for all games.
- 9) All players must register upon arrival. Leave of absence shall be granted only by the Referee or his deputy.
- 10) The Entry Form must be accompanied by an Entry Fee of 50 cents per player per event.
- 11) Entries close at 6.00pm on Sunday, 10th June, 1979.
- 12) The S. E. T. T. A. Executive Committee reserve the right to modify the programme in any way it feels expedient
- 13) Entrants who do not fulfil their obligations shall be liable to disciplinary measures by the S.E.T.T.A.
