(b) due to the intention to pay the present Meteorological Observer/Wireless Operator strength of 14 a further special duty meteorological observer allowance of £18 per annum, in addition to the present Wireless Operator special duty allowance of £18 per annum. It has been proposed that the grant of the further allowance should be left in abeyance until the Salaries Commission takes place but this is not agreed and the matter has been taken up separately.

(c) due to the intention to increase the Special Branch by a further three Europeans and six Africans, who will all draw the approved special duty allowance (Europeans £40 per annum, Africans £18 per annum).

Item 3. Temporary Assistance: Increase £111.

The increase is due to the intention to station horses and mules at four additional posts to enable more extensive patrolling, and daily-paid herds will be required at each post.

SUBHEAD B. TRANSPORT AND TRAVELLING.

Item 1. Travelling. Decrease £3,293.

Despite a net decrease in the provision under the subhead, there is an increase of £1,000 under sub-item (a) Travelling Expenses, due to increased travelling/...
