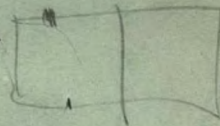

NOTICE TO EMPLOYERS OF NATIVE LABOUR.
(Act No. 67 of 1952)

The law requires every Native of the age of 16 years or over to be in possession of a Reference Book containing his/her photograph. The book will take the place of all other documents that a Native is required to carry.

Under the provisions of Section 4 of Act 67 of 1952, identity cards for Natives are incorporated in their reference books to give effect to the terms of Section 13 of the Population Registration Act No. 30 of 1950.

Employers should complete portion "B" of the reference book and keep a record of the number of the book in case it is lost or destroyed.

Parts "A", "C" and "D" of the Female reference book and "A", "C", "D" and "E" of the Male reference book are for official use and do not directly concern the employer.

A registration unit will operate at the undermentioned places on the dates indicated. Both Native males and females will be registered. If the numbers of Natives presenting themselves are more than can be registered in one day, the official in charge will announce a further date when Natives may be sent to the same place.

Natives presenting themselves for registration must be in possession of 2s. for the photographs, and for an additional 1s.6d. a suitable wallet in which the book can be stored can be obtained.

NATIVE FEMALES.

Under the powers vested in me by section two of the Natives (Abolition of Passes and Co-ordination of Documents) Act, 1952 (Act No. 67 of 1952), I, HENDRIK FRENCH VERWOERD, Minister of Native Affairs, do hereby require every female Native, who has attained the age of sixteen years and is resident in one of the areas specified below, to appear before the officer during the period and at the place so specified in each case opposite the area in question between the hours of 8.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m., on weekdays other than Saturdays and public holidays, and between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturdays in order that a reference book in the form determined by me and set out in Government Notice No. 1346, dated 27th July, 1956, may be issued to her:-
