

MEMORENDUM of Agreement made and entered into between
Headman Seru Tawana of Mafeking and Cornelius Peypere of
Stinkboom-hoiud, near Zeerust at Mafeking on this 10th
day of Sephember 1913.

WITNESSITH: (1) That party of the first part does hereby allow party of the second part to conduct Blacksmith work in his farm, at Maroyana in the Bechuanaland Protectorate for a period of four months commencing from the 1st day of October 1913.

- (2). In liu of rent party of the second part shall keep in constant repairs two certain wogons of the party of the first part, at his expense.
- (3) Party of the second part shall not for any purpose whatever cut down, bark, or otherwise injure any trees or cut down or destroy any underwood or brushwood on the land or permit any one to do so, he will however get permission from the owner should he desire to cut down any tree, underwood or brushwood.
